RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF MULTIPLE GRANTS AND LETTERS OF INQUIRY TO OFFSET THE COST OF THE IN-SQUAD COMPUTER EQUIPMENT FOR THE AKELEY POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Akeley agrees to comply with all regulations, guidelines and also accepts the proposed use(s) of the requested monies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Clerk Treasurer and of Deputy Clerk are authorized to sign the grant agreement or any other document in connection therewith.
